Mock Court:



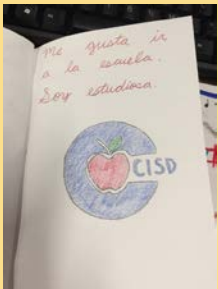
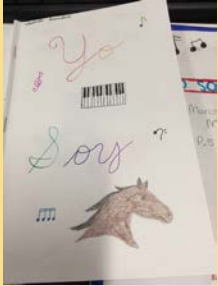
