GPA Waiver for 2017-2018

Current sophomores and juniors may apply to waive specific courses from counting in their GPA. This is recommended only for students with a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher. CTE Interest Forms for 2017-2018

Many of our career related courses (CTE) fill up fast, and we use the CTE Interest Form to help us reserve seats for students. AP Testing

Students taking AP courses are expected to take the corresponding AP exams. CHS is able to supplement the costs of these exams which are usually over \$85!
