GPA Waiver for 2017-2018 School Year-

Current sophomores and juniors may apply to waive specific courses from counting in their GPA, this is suggested only for students with a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher. Many of our career related courses (CTE) fill up fast and we use this interest form to help us reserve seats for students.
