CISD covers a large, demographically diverse region, encompassing 348 square miles. More than 63,000 students attend seven high schools, three 9th grade campuses, seven junior high schools, and numerous elementary and intermediate campuses. Conroe ISD is currently ranked as the 65th largest district in the United States and the 11th largest district in Texas.

Conroe, is the fastest growing community in the nation. It is bordered by 22,000 – acre Lake Conroe, Sam Houston National Forest and W. SCHOOL DAY AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The school day consists of seven periods with each period approximately lasting 55 minutes. Students are expected to graduate on the Foundation High School Program with Endorsements. This 26 program requires:

English 4 credits	Mathematics 4 credits

Language other than English 2 credits	Health ½ credit

Electives 5 ½ credits	

Students must also obtain passing scores on all of the following STAAR tests: English I and II, Algebra I, Biology and US History.

MARKING SCALE AND GRADE POINTS

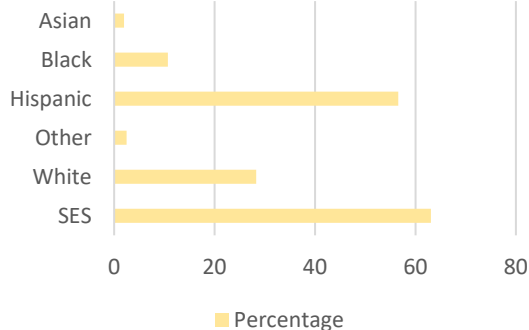

A student's grade point average is determined by dividing the total number of grade points by the number of semester courses attempted. All state accredited courses are considered in the calculation. 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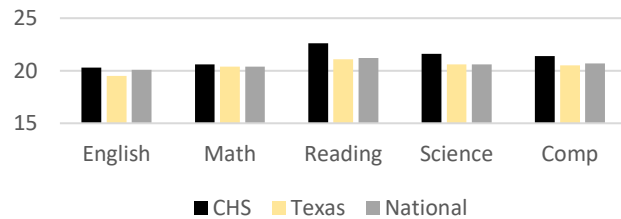

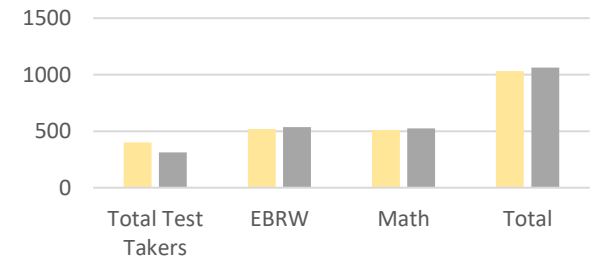
