

# Parking Regulations

- Students enrolled at Conroe High School are allowed to use their own transportation to and from school
  - CHS is not responsible for accidents, losses, or damages to vehicles that occur on the school parking lots
  - All accidents, thefts, or other problems should be reported to the appropriate assistant principal or campus security
- All students driving cars or motorcycles to school must register the vehicle with the school
  - To register you must give license plate numbers, show a valid driver's license, and proof of insurance in the student's name
  - You will not be allowed to park on campus without a school parking permit
  - Permits are \$50 per school year and can be paid on-line
  - Parking tags are not transferable
- Parking may be suspended or revoked for violating parking regulations as well as violations of the Student Code of Conduct
  - 1<sup>st</sup> parking violation = a warning and a review of parking rules and regulations
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> offense = suspension of parking privileges
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> violation = may result in permanent loss of parking privileges
- Any student needing to leave the parking lot because of an emergency must sign out in the attendance office or assistant principal
  - Students involved in extracurricular activities are not considered early release
- **Speed limit in all parking lots is 10 m.p.h.**
- Fire lanes and bus routes must remain open
  - Police officers may take suitable action to maintain the fire lanes and bus routes
- All persons picking up students should come to the front of the school building on Highway 105 to eliminate congestion in the bus loading area on Wilson Road.
  - Please observe the Exit Only signs at the front of Conroe High School.
- Students driving vehicles other than the one with a parking hang tag should contact campus security for a temporary parking permit.
- Students may not park in areas or spaces designated for school employees.
  - This includes the area around trash dumpsters, fire lanes, or gates.
- Students may not park in front of the school before leaving for a school activity.
- Students may not loiter in cars or the parking lot at any time.
- Students who must return to their vehicle during the school day must obtain a pass from the assistant principal.
- If a student violates the attendance laws by leaving campus or taking other students off campus, he/she may lose parking privileges.
